Here are a few things you need to bring:

- Water Bottle
- Bath Towel
- Shower Articles/Toiletries
- Alarm Clock
- Appropriate Clothing (Hot, Sunny Days/Cool Evenings)
- Sun Block
- Bug Spray
- Hat (Prevent Sunstroke)
- Athletic Shoes (For Marching)
- Sleeping Bag & Pillow

You will need to bring a pair of marching sized snare drum sticks and a rubber-type practice pad or an INVADER practice pad (No Remo pads please). We use these every morning in our small group instruction. You should also plan on bringing the instrument you will be playing in the fall including a harness! (snare , quads, or bass drum) PIT INSTRUMENTS ARE PROVIDED. Also, as was mentioned on the website, we will be having three nights of DRUM CIRCLES around the campfire! Matt Savage is an expert in this field and will be leading the sessions. Everyone should bring some type of hand drum...bongos, a conga, a frame drum, or some type of ethnic drum. If there is no way you can bring such a drum then at least bring a cowbell or woodblock!
